

Our homes have to work harder than ever, as living spaces, offices and more.

Here's how to make multifunctional living stylish, sorted and stress free.


The past 18 months have seen a huge shift in the way we use our homes. Not just places to relax, eat and sleep, they've become gyms and workspaces, school rooms and nurseries, cinemas and virtual cocktail bars. While many of us have embraced the opportunity to spend more time at home, there's no denying the pressure this has put on our living spaces. But it's also given us an opportunity to consider what we truly want from our home going forward.

'The pandemic has reshaped the way we use our homes,' says Marc von Grundherr, Director of London estate agent Benham and Reeves. 'Flexible working has seen spare bedrooms, lounges and garden sheds transformed into home office spaces. While working from the sofa was a novel experience during the early days of lockdown, we've realised that blurring the lines between our professional and personal lives can be detrimental. It's incredibly important to differentiate between the two and switch on and off at the appropriate times.'

Multifunctional houses

When rooms have more than one purpose, it's important to keep their roles as distinct as possible. And good organisation - and fantastic storage - is key.

'You need to set up your home to support the exact life you want,' says Shira Gill, home organiser and author of Minimalista: Your Step-by-Step Guide to a Better Home, Wardrobe, and Life (Octopus). 'Once you have clarity about what you need, you can assess every space in your home against those goals.'



Having rooms that are muddled, more than multifunctional, is a common problem. 'I encounter living rooms that feel unliveable and dining rooms that aren't used for dining,' agrees Shira. 'The goal is to develop a clear vision for

the spaces you want to create and the activities you want the rooms to support.'

Design for living

The recent surge in DIY, decorating, renovations and extensions is proof that when we spend more time at home we see its flaws - and its potential.

'Lockdown has opened our eyes to the quality of our furniture and how it can affect our wellbeing,' says Farhan Malik of Manor Interiors. 'In the same way that an uncomfortable bed can reduce our ability to sleep, a poorquality desk can impact our ability to work. Our research shows that a tidy workspace can boost both productivity and personal wellbeing, and we've found that good storage is integral for maintaining order and reducing stress in our homes.'

A more flexible way of living and working looks like it is here to stay, so it makes sense to invest in creating a stylish, healthy, multifunctional home. And you can rest assured that the investment will pay off in other ways, too.

'Maximising space within your house will help boost appeal for buyers. The easiest way to do this is with in-built storage as it maximises space and removes the need to buy additional furniture,' confirms James Forrester of Birmingham estate agent, Barrows & Forrester. 'We regularly see buyers

pay that little bit extra for built-in storage options such as wardrobes. The pandemic has emphasised the need for more space and these additional features are now likely to add even more value to your home." ■

TIP 1:

Don't put it down; put it away.

Treating your belongings and your space with respect feels good, and waking up to a space that feels curated and cared for is dreamy.

TIP 3:

Relocate and reset.





My relationship with Hammonds goes back a very long time; I'm such a fan! I've always been obsessed with fitted furniture – as a child, I loved looking around showrooms and seeing how all the cabinets and accessories fitted together.

I first went to see Hammonds several years ago and now I've got the plans for my new wardrobes. It's brilliant that the designs can be personalised to what's important to each customer. I love shoes, so I've specified a 'shoedrobe' in one section. I also wear fewer evening dresses than I used to, preferring to wear a tuxedo to events. So I've a smaller full-length hanging area for coats and a few frocks, but more half-hanging space for trousers and tops.

Having a beautiful wardrobe gives you more respect for the clothes you own. Instead of throwing them over the back of a chair, you'll hang them up and keep everything better organised. That's more important than ever, postpandemic, as we really need to feel in control of our lives.

I play 'dress up' in my wardrobe every Sunday and choose all my outfits for the week ahead. Take seven hangers and create a complete look for each day, down to the shoes and jewellery. It might be athleisure, but elevate it so you're wearing more than just a tracksuit. Feeling good isn't about being a certain size or following the latest trend. It's the confidence that comes with presenting the best version of yourself. When you put together outfits you feel good wearing, it impacts how you show up in the world.

Editing your wardrobe so it only contains pieces that fit you and are flattering will save you time and stress when you're getting dressed.

Pinterest is a great tool for figuring out what fashion feels right for you. Look for celebrities with a similar body shape and style to you, then create mood boards of their best looks to inspire you when you go clothes shopping. I also recommend doing your hair and makeup and wearing a great pair of shoes when trying on clothes even when it's a home delivery!

Be your own best friend. So many of us talk to ourselves in a way we'd never speak to a friend, and we need to re-programme that negative commentary. Jot down mantras and kind messages to yourself on sticky notes and pop them inside your wardrobe or on the dressing table mirror. One message will override negative thoughts and create a more positive mindset.

RECIPE More Taste & Less Waste

Sticky Apple Fritters

Serves 2 Preparation 10 minutes Cooking 10 minutes •

Ingredients

Dessert apple 1, eg Pink Lady

Plain flour 75g (3oz)

Ground cloves ½ tsp

Salt pinch

Milk 100ml (3½fl oz)

Egg 1, separated

Rapeseed oil for deep frying

Icing sugar, golden syrup and vanilla ice cream to serve

Method

Cut the apple into quarters, peel and core, then cut in half to give eight wedges.

Tip the flour into a bowl and stir in the cloves and salt. Beat in the milk and egg yolk. Whisk the egg white until stiff and then fold it into the batter.

In a deep frying pan, heat the oil to 180-190°C (350-375°F).

Carefully dip a wedge of apple into the batter and then lower it into the hot oil. Repeat with another three wedges. Cook the apple fritters for 3-4 minutes, turning them over halfway through, until they are golden. Using a slotted spoon, lift them onto kitchen paper to drain while you cook the remaining fritters. Dust with icing sugar and serve immediately, with golden syrup and ice cream.

Plum & Almond **Brown Betty**

Serves 2 Preparation 10 minutes Cooking 40 minutes

Ingredients

Fresh white or wholemeal breadcrumbs

100g (3½oz)

Butter 50g (2oz), melted

Soft light brown sugar 2 tbsp

Flaked almonds 2 tbsp, lightly crushed

Plums 200g (7oz), halved, stoned and thickly sliced

Almond extract ½ tsp

Plum jam 2 tbsp

Custard or ice cream to serve

Method

Preheat the oven to 180°C/160°fan/Gas 4. Put the breadcrumbs in a bowl and mix in the butter and sugar. Scatter half the mixture over the bottom of a small ovenproof dish. Mix the almonds into the remaining crumbs.

Arrange the plums in the dish. Mix the almond extract into the jam and spoon over the plums, then top with the almondy crumbs.

Put the dish on a baking tray and bake for about 40 minutes until the topping is crisp and golden and the plums are tender - test with a skewer. Serve hot with custard or ice cream.
