# Creating The Perfect Flower Arrangements

MULTI-TALENTED HAMMONDS STORE DEMONSTRATOR CORINNE SHARES WITH US HER FABULOUS FLORAL HOBBY.

“It all started when I got married 15 years ago. For my wedding I decided to purchase and arrange the flowers myself. When so many people complimented me on how nice they looked, I realised I had a bit of a knack for it. So I decided to enrol in some training. It can be physically hard work creating large floral arrangements, with lots of lifting and fetching but it's worth it for the beautiful end result.



I absolutely love it!”  
Corinne shares some of her top tips when creating the perfect arrangement for a family get together or a sumptuous dinner party. Here you will see she has created a wonderful arrangement to go on a table in the hallway to welcome your guests or on the kitchen windowsill, and a smaller arrangement which will sit beautifully on a dining room table.▷▷





## CORINNE'S TOP TIPS

“Firstly think about the container, consider the size of the space you intend to place your arrangement. A container too small will be lost, but don't choose something too large that doesn't fit well in the space.

If you wish to use oasis (a foam with which you can place the flowers in and they stay placed) then make sure it is well soaked in water. Allow it to naturally take it in and don't be tempted to push it into the water. When the top of the oasis is level with the water take it out right away or it will be over-soaked and crumble upon use. When securing the stems into place, make sure they stay in the oasis for water supply. If you do accidentally push it in too far, pull it out and make another hole or the flower will wilt quickly. Always add cut flower food into the vase water, it makes a difference. Change the water every three to four days.

A large range of supermarkets

supply good quality, cost effective flowers, but for a special occasion you can't beat a specialist. Most flowers should be picked when they are in bud or half open, meaning you will have the pleasure of watching them open up. However, be cautious if picked too tightly in bud, they may never open. This is especially true with Tulips, Irises, Daffodils and Roses. Allow space between your feature flowers to avoid overcrowding, use fillers such as a Gypsophila, Waxflower or ferny foliage to act as a stepping stone between other materials.

For the larger arrangement I used Peonies and Roses as the feature flowers and Waxflower, Alstroemeria and long leafed Eucalyptus as fillers”

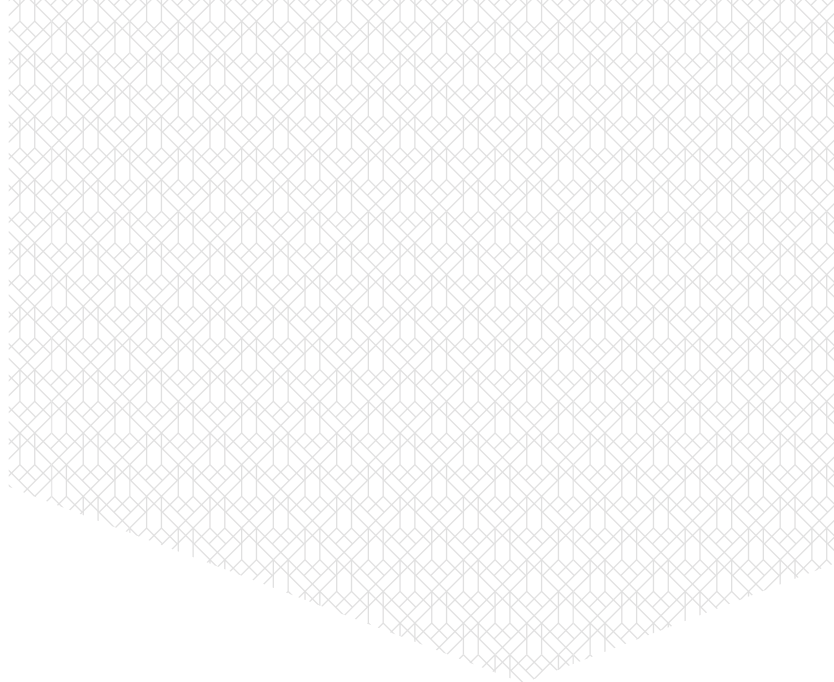

First things first. A big breakfast. Head to The Refectory, a contemporary family run bistro specialising in breakfasts and brunches, served all day too! Located on St Dunstan's Street, the atmosphere is friendly and the food is delicious, what a great way

to start the day. Next, kick off the morning activities with a different perspective on the beautiful city. Take a boat trip along the River Stour which runs through Canterbury. The tour starts from the bridge by the Old Weavers restaurant, a 5 minute walk from The Refectory, and sights expected to see are beautiful views of the Cathedral and the >>





breathtaking old chapel known as Greyfriars, built in the 13th Century.

After a relaxing float along the river, take a two minute walk over to The Beaney House of Art and Knowledge. First opened in 1899, it is a very pretty grade II listed building. More quirky than your run of the mill museum, this house features a small art gallery, as well as collections of precious artifacts. By the time you finish your ramblings about The Beaney House you'll be right in the centre ready for a spot of lunch. There are many wonderful restaurants and pubs in Canterbury; Thomas Beckett, The Shakespeare and The Old Buttermarket, just to name a few to explore, so you won't be stuck for choice.

No visit to Canterbury would be complete without a visit to the majestic Cathedral. Steeped in history and grandeur it really is a fabulous sight to behold and worth an explore.

After soaking up the history of the city, take

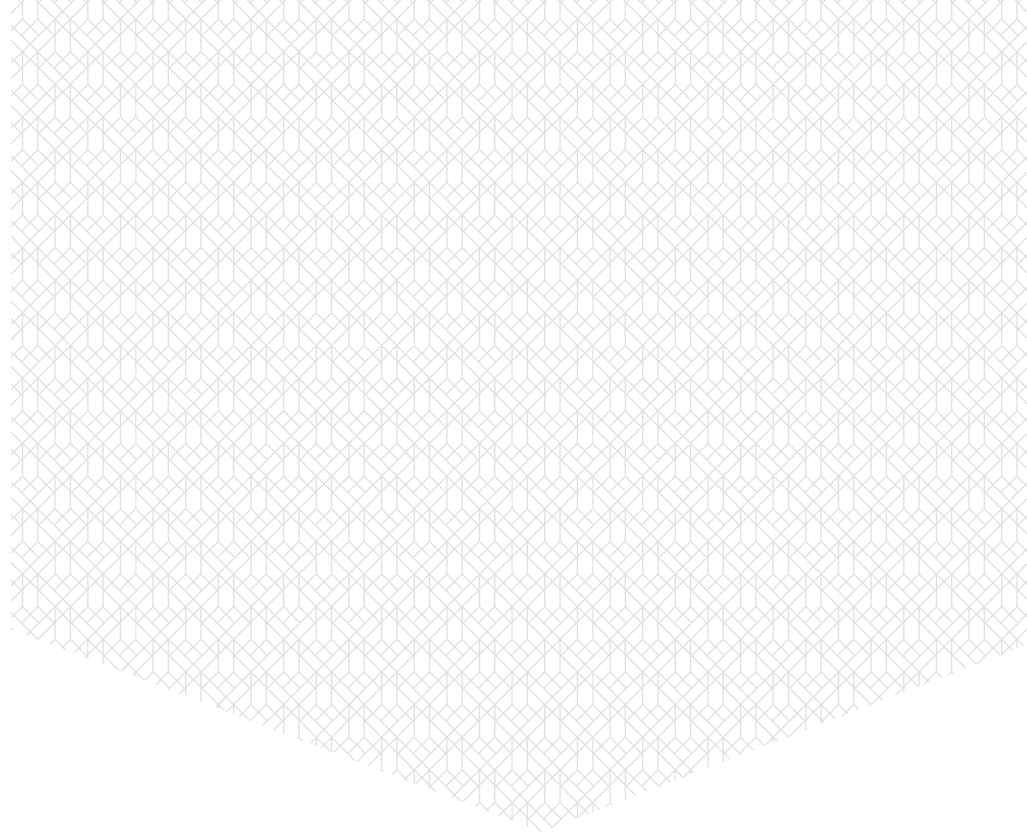
it easy for an hour or so with a stroll along the high street. There are many independent boutiques and vintage shops to get lost in. Bring back some fudge for the family or a trinket or two from the collection of gift shops.

Dinner and a show! Grab a bite to eat at one of the many wonderful restaurants amongst the city of Canterbury. Alternatively, head on over to The Marlowe Theatre first and dine at The Green Room, the inhouse restaurant facing the river with wonderful views of the Cathedral. The Green Room serves delectable meals including a specially selected pre-show menu. Once you've done that you'll be ready to sit back and enjoy the show. The theatre has a wonderful selection on a regular basis from comedy sketches to mystifying plays. Choose one to suit you and your traveling partner's taste.

Depending on how long the show lasts,

and if you still have enough energy, why not finish off your day with a drink at an elegant cocktail bar or pub. Canterbury has lots of them, Lady Luck, Bramley's and The Ballroom are all a short walk from the theatre and have a great atmosphere.

Make your day trip into a mini-break and take the short drive to Howletts Zoo and Leeds Castle the following day. Howletts is not just a zoo but a breeding centre for rare and endangered animals. The large areas that the animals have to roam around in makes the site special, knowing that from the African elephants to the Pallas cat, they're not only in great care but also a great sight for the visitors. Leeds Castle, previously owned by 6 medieval queens with 500 acres of parkland and gardens, is all a sight to behold. Explore the castle rooms and gardens, but what's more see a falconry display, let the kids clamber about the playground



and grab a bite to eat at the restaurant and café.

What more could tempt you into a weekend away to Canterbury? Of course while you're there, pop by our newly revamped Hammonds showroom. # Salmon & Salad Recipe

A QUICK, SIMPLE AND DELICIOUS MEAL TO TRY THIS SUMMER

Long, light days mean we have more hours in the evening to enjoy with friends, family and loved ones. We've created a dish so simple to do it takes minutes to prepare and is packed full of delicious fresh

flavours; allowing you to spend more time relaxing in the garden on a bright summer's evening. What's more, by cooking a whole salmon, you can feed a party of guests or a large family easily.

## Ingredients

### **For the fish**

3-4kg/6.5-10lb in weight, gutted and cleaned  
4 sprigs fresh parsley  
½ lemon, sliced  
2 bay leaves  
150ml/5fl oz dry white wine  
2 tbsp vegetable oil  
3 cloves of garlic, smashed with skin still on  
1 small artichoke, sliced into quarters

### **For the salad**

Cucumber, cut into ribbons with peeler  
1 little gem lettuce shredded  
140g beansprouts  
Bunch coriander, leaves roughly chopped  
Bunch mint, leaves roughly chopped

### **For the dressing**

1 tsp rice wine vinegar  
1 tbsp fish sauce  
½ tsp light muscavado sugar  
2 red chillies, deseeded and finely chopped

## Method

- 1 – Preheat the oven to gas 5/190C/375F.
- 2 – Take 2 large sheets of foil and place on top of each other in a roasting tin. Spread the oil on the foil and place the salmon on top.
- 3 – Take the parsley, bay leaves and half of the lemon slices and place inside the body cavity.
- 4 – Place the remaining slices around the body along with the garlic and artichoke quarters.
- 5 – Pour the white wine in the parcel and wrap, covering the fish.
- 6 – Bake for 50-60 minutes.
- 7 – For the dressing mix the ingredients together in a bowl and pour over the salad just before the fish is ready to serve.





# A Chat With Designer Christine

TALENTED HAMMONDS INTERIOR DESIGNER CHRISTINE CROXON SHARES WITH US A BRIEF INSIGHT INTO HER WORLD AND LOVE OF DESIGN.

When we first met Christine Croxon, we were greeted with a smile and a laugh that could light up a room. We were eager to discover more about her and her role in Hammonds so we could shine the spotlight on one of our valued expert designers.

### **Can you tell me a little about your day?**

“I tend to kick start my day with a cup of tea and some poached eggs on toast, a big breakfast to keep me going throughout the day ahead. Shortly after I head out to my scheduled appointments. At Hammonds we have three time slots available for design visits in the day. These tend to last around 2 hours.

Every appointment is different, which is great to keep me on my toes.

Sometimes the customer knows exactly what they want, sometimes they don't have a clue, but that's why we're here, to guide them in the right direction and work it out together. I sit down with the customer with a hot drink and ask them as many questions as I can including what colours they are interested in, and what type of storage they need. I use my knowledge of interior design and Hammonds Furniture to select the best choice based on their personality, style and also what would suit the room.

Some designers go through all the ranges and samples before getting the laptop out, I like to get the template onto Artica first so that the customer can visualise the room, with the furniture, and then select the best range for them.”

## How long have you been with Hammonds?

"I have been at Hammonds for about 27 years now and have enjoyed every year. Before that I worked at Truman Brewery as the first female district manager. During that time I was involved in a lot of development schemes working with architects as I had a natural flair for using space."

## What about outside of work?

"In my spare time, I enjoy being with the family. This weekend we are having a surprise 65th non-retirement party for my Uncle, I don't think he'll ever retire. The whole family, and it's a big family, will be there which will be wonderful."

**"I've always been quite artistic and creative, which is what led me to become an interior designer. My Dad was an engineer and was always knocking the walls down, so I learnt at an early age how knocking a wall down or making a doorway could influence things in a room. I began to see how the small changes you can make with some material and a splash of colour can make a room look brilliant. I love what I do and I'm so glad I got into it."**
